Hoistway Requirements



Rail Backing: Installed per manufacturer's specifications – generally 2" x 10" LVLs or dimensional lumber capped with 2" x 4"s

Drywall: Generally, 1 layer of 5/8" drywall – taped and finished. 2 layers of drywall required in the city of Chicago

Elevator Pit: Per the manufacturer's requirements – as a general rule - 8" minimum required; 10" to 12" recommended



Electrical Needs: Dedicated 220 VAC with 30 amp circuit for the elevator and dedicated 110 VAC with 15 amp circuit for the lights with a switched light and GFI outlet at the bottom of the hoist-way and in the control area

Hydraulic:

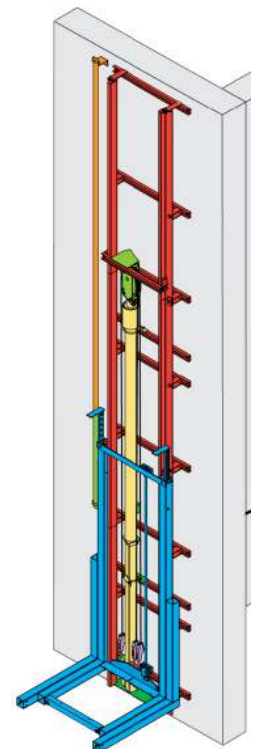
